Library Citizenship Rules

- *Sign a circulation card for each book you borrow.*
- *Return books on time so other students may borrow them.*
- *Check-out privileges will be withheld until all borrowed books have been returned to the library.*
- *The library is a place to read quietly and explore new books. It is not the time to play*
- *If a student loses or damages a book beyond repair, s/he must pay for its replacement before taking out another book.*
- *Keep the library neat and orderly.*
